
STOP & READ


Please ensure you briefly read over this instruction manual before attempting to assemble and fit your U-shape furniture. Once you have an understanding of the process, please read and follow each page step by step, failure to do this can result in mistakes and the process taking much longer.

Please note, some pictures contain our Deluxe furniture range with knock on edging, however all principles of the instructions remain the same. All the information you need is in this manual

These instructions have been broken down into two manuals, the first phase is the construction of the furniture, the second is the 'Plug & Play' electrical and appliance installation. Please ensure you follow in order.

STOP AND READ

Ensure you only use <u>15mm screws</u> provided, or screws that come with hardware such as drawers and hinges

When using 25mm screws pilot drill first and never counter sink (unless stated otherwise)

Failure to do the above can result in screwing through the outer side of the material

A good workbench is advised for all following prep work



OILING

It is extremely important to treat the edges of your ply and Oak products. Failure to do this can result in bowing and delamination due to moisture ingress.

You can apply an oil, a varnish or wax. We recommend Osmo top oil, there are a few shades of colour available. The oil also passes health and hygiene standards for worktops and works well on the ply edges.

Treating your edges also makes for a beautify finish







Quick tip – sand down all edges before oiling for a cleaner finish

Repeat for the Worktop and handles, ensure to seal every exposed edge





Ally to dry and apply two coats

HANGING DOORS



TOOLS

- Drill Driver
- Stanley knife
- Cross head Screw driver





HANGING DOORS

THE FOLLOWING DOORS NEED HANGING

-PIECE 17 AND 18 SEAT BASE OPENINGS -PIECE 1 DOORS (WITHOUT DRAWS ONLY) -PIECE 8 -PIECE 15

-POD DOOR AND TOP LOCKER



HINGES



Fix the hinges to the door only using 15mm screws and the pilot holes provided




If your hinges have the cover plates clip them on




Turn the adjustment all the way to the rear before fixing to the aperture



HINGES



Remove Euro screws (if necessary) and replace with 15mm screws to fit the plate to the aperture



Once both hinges are fitted, adjust the door to fit flush with equal spacing




HANGING DOORS

CHECK & MAKE SURE...

The doors sit flush and open and close correctly



HANDLES



Fit the handles using the 25mm bolts



Align the holes with the pre-drilled holes on the doors and tighten





DRAWER ASSEMBLY





DRAWER ASSEMBLY

THE FOLLOWING DRAWERS NEED BUILDING

-REAR NS DRAWER X 1 -REAR OS DRAWER X 1 OR X 2

POD



DRAWER ASSEMBLY



Attach the mounting clips




Fit the drawer rear using 15mm screws




Fit the drawer base using 15 mm screws, ensure the base is flush to avoid gaps



SOFT CLOSE DRAWER ASSEMBLY



Fit the drawer face catch or oak handle (neither if push drawer)



Screw the drawer face mounts into the pilot holes with the 4 x large head screws provided with the drawer box



Clip the face into the side runners



NS HIGH DRAWER



Insert the bar holder, use a mallet to knock into place



Fit the bar and screw to tighten, this will adjust the drawer face when in position




Clip the sides on



DRAWER RUNNERS







Tap into place with a mallet and use 25mm screws into the 5 pilot holes like the picture, Arrows up





Now you can screw the draw runners to the block using the pilot holes and screws provided with the drawer

DRAWER RUNNERS




Fit the runners using the pilot holes provided, ensure you have the correct runner on each side.



DRAWER RUNNERS







Tap into place with a mallet and use 25mm screws into the 5 pilot holes like the picture, Arrows up







Now you can screw the draw runners to the block using the pilot holes and screws provided with the drawer

PUSH TABLE RUNNERS







Align where the runners pull out forward in the direction of the arrow



Use a block to ensure its perfectly square to the top, and front/ back



CONTINUE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO ASSEMBLE THE U-SHAPE






Offer the support blocks into place and screw from the rear using 25mm screws



Use the pilot holes and stickers to fit








Screw 14 and 14A into position on piece 4. dress piece 14A to the wheel arch as seen in the picture





Screw piece 6 to 6A, ensure perfectly flush



Use the pilot holes and 25mm screws



Screw the table leg to the underside of 20 using 4 x 20mm screws



DOOR CATCHES





For piece 8 fit the return block into the rebate using a chock block, this will provide a return to fit the magnetic hinges as before



DOOR CATCHES




First fit the magnet to the return face, use the floor for doors under the worktop



Offer the strike plate to the magnet for correct positioning, mark the two holes





Pilot drill the two holes with a 2mm bit and screw the plate using the screws provided. Do not screw too near the edge as the ply can split

FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS INSTRUCTION MANUAL, WE HAVE BUILT THE U-SHAPE OUT OF THE VEHICLE. ALTHOUGH YOU CAN BUILD MOSTLY OUTSIDE, PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE STAGE WHERE WORK CONTINUES INSIDE THE VAN


REFER TO THE LABELLED DIAGRAM ON SLIDE 5 TO HELP WITH THE PROCESS



THE PROCESS

Build then offer rear section into the van

Fit all seat bases









Build both side sections



Attach side sections to rear section in the vehicle

Add draws, table and cushions



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A good workbench is advised for all following prep work





Slide 3 and 11 together




slide 4 and 5 together with 3 and 11 as per picture



Place 2/2A into 4 rebate





Fit 6 x chock blocks to 1



Clip 1 into rebates and screw into place



Ensure 2/2A, 3 and 5 are 45mm from the top of 1



THIS FRAMEWORK CAN NOW BE PUT INTO THE VAN, PIECE ONE IS DESIGNED TO FIT AT THE VERY REAR INBETWEEN THE D PILLARS





Attach 6/6A to 9 using chock blocks and pilot holes



Screw 9 to 15 using 25mm screws, ensure orientation is correct with both rebates flush together




Attach 7 to 15 using pilot holes provided





Use 23 as a width guide between 7 and 6A (do not attach




Fit 8 using chock blocks and pilot holes provided



Screw through 7 into 7A using 25mm screws





Loosen screws that attach 8 to 6/6A to allow the fitment of seat base 21/21A



Ensure 21/21A is seated correctly and flush into rebates, reattach 8





Adjust the hinges on 21A so the flap will open freely



Attach 10 to 12 using chock blocks and pilot holes



Screw 10 to 16 using 25mm screws, ensure orientation is correct with both rebates flush together



Screw through 12 into 12A using 25mm screws





Fit the N/S pod section to the rear section in the van (base 21/21A should already be fitted)



Repeat for the O/S



Offer 13 into position and fit by screwing through the rear of 4 using 25mm screws



OFFER THE SEAT BASES INTO POSITION, THEY ATTACH
TO THE FARMWORK BY SCREWING DOWN WITH
25MM SCREWS. ENSURE TO SCREW THROUGH THE
CENTRE OF THE PLY TO PREVENT SPLITTING, PREDRILLING FIST IS ADVISABLE

SEE NEXT SLIDE FOR EXAMPLES, ENSURE ALL BASES
ARE FITTED CORRECTLY AND SCREWED WHERE
NECESSARY



BEFORE FITTING YOUR U-SHAPE TO THE VEHICLE, ENSURE YOU ARE IN THE CORRECT POSITION. PLACE 20 INTO THE BED POSITION AND USE THE WIDTH GUIDE (PIECE 22)

PIECE 1 SHOULD BE BETWEEN THE D PILLARS ON TOP OF THE PLASTIC THRESHOLD AT THE REAR OF THE VAN

PIECE 8 WILL FIT PERFECTLY OVER THE STEP AND OFFER UP
TO THE INSIDE OF DOOR PILLAR

ONCE IN POSITION YOU CAN FIT YOUR U-SHAPE TO THE VAN WITH CHOCK BLOCKS AND ANGLE BRACKETS, USE THE LONGEST SCREWS POSSIBLE INTO THE FLOOR AND NEVER SEAT DURING TRANSIT!





Place 20 on top of 21, place the folding leg into hole in 21. Dress 20 towards the centre and front of van. When positioned correctly, place the bed slats in the gaps with an even gap, then screw the slats to 21 and 21A. This design allows the seats and bed to both be flush





All assembly principles of fitting hardware such as hinges, handles, chock blocks and drawer runners apply as per previous slides.





Fit the hinges to the pod door



Fit the handles using the 25mm bolts





Fit the drawer runners to the fridge pods, no blocks are required this time, ensure orientated correct



Prepare to assemble by firstly fitting all chock blocks using pilot holes provided.

End panel



Fridge pod (R)





Attach the rear support over the fridge pod (R) and into the right end panel



Attach and fit the fridge pod left



Align the pilot holes on the face and the right end panel and fit with chock blocks





Mount and fit the worktop



Hang the fridge door




Assemble drawer as per previous slides and fit to runners





Slide in the shelf from the rear and screw into place



Fit the door magnetic catch



Finally offer your unit into position and fit to the vehicle




TOP LOCKER



Fit the hinges into the doors



Screw the top locker dividers together using 25mm screws




Fit the chock blocks to the top locker top support



TOP LOCKER



Fit the chock blocks to the end panels



Fit the divider to the base, ensure the step (circled) is facing the front denoted by the door hinge pilot holes (arrowed)





Fit the end panels

TOP LOCKER



Fit the top support



Finally hang and adjust the doors. The square end panels will need scribing on fit
